# Gubernatorial Candidates Outline Positions on Water

With Californians set to elect a new governor in less than three weeks, water has emerged as an important topic in the 2010 gubernatorial race.

Democratic candidate Jerry Brown released a water plan this week that calls for significant investments in the state's water supply infrastructure and natural ecosystems. Brown's "Water Plan for the 21st Century" also calls for action to restore the Bay-Delta and meet California's true water needs.



Republican contender Meg Whitman outlined her position on water earlier this year in her plan, "Building a New California." The plan says investments in above- and below-ground water storage are needed to ensure the state has adequate water reserves. Whitman has endorsed the \$11.14 billion water bond now slated for the November 2012 ballot.

Both candidates voice support for conveyance improvements in the Delta.

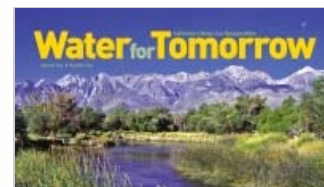
