MUNICIPAL WATER DISTRICT REELECTS PRESIDENT AND VICE PRESIDENT

Fountain Valley, CA (January 21, 2015) – This morning, the Board of Directors of the Municipal Water District of Orange County (MWDOC) unanimously voted to reelect Larry Dick as Board President and Wayne Osborne as Vice President. President Dick and Vice President Osborne were previously elected to their respective positions in 2014.

President Dick has served on the MWDOC Board for fourteen consecutive years (he was first elected in 2000). He represents MWDOC Division 2, which includes the cities of Garden Grove, Orange, Tustin, Villa Park, and unincorporated North Tustin. He has also served as one of MWDOC's four representatives on the Metropolitan Water District of Southern California's Board of Directors since 2003. President Dick is a longtime member of the Water Advisory Committee of Orange County, having served as Chairman twice. He currently serves as President of the Orange County Water Facilities Corporation and Director of the Urban Water Institute. He has also served as an officer of the Independent Special Districts of Orange County.

Vice President Osborne has served on the MWDOC Board since 2012. He represents Division Three, which includes the cities of Cypress, Fountain Valley, Los Alamitos, Stanton, Westminster, the western portion of Garden Grove, and nearby portions of unincorporated Orange County. Osborne has a long history of service to the water industry, having worked as the City of Fountain Valley's Director of Public Works and Engineering for 33 years.
