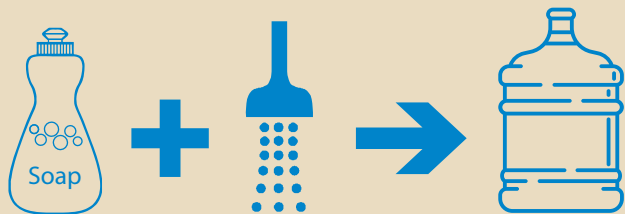


# *Cleaning & Preparing* WATER STORAGE CONTAINERS

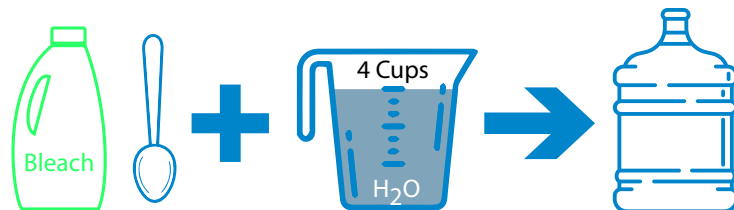
Use a clean food-grade water storage container — such as those found at a camping supply store — or a container that is made out of durable materials and can be closed tightly. **DO NOT USE** containers that once held toxic chemicals.



- 1 Wash** the storage container and **Rinse** completely with water.



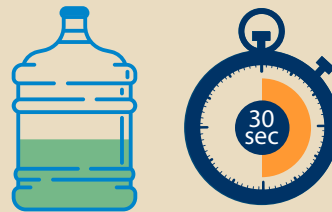
- 2 Sanitize** the container with a solution made by mixing 1 teaspoon of unscented liquid bleach in 4 cups of water.



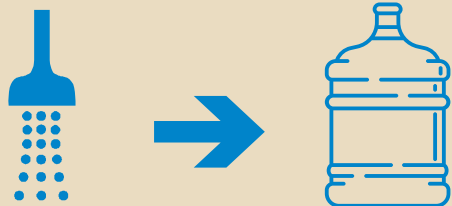
- 3 Cover** the container tightly and **Shake** it well. Make sure the sanitizing bleach solution touches all inside surfaces of the container.



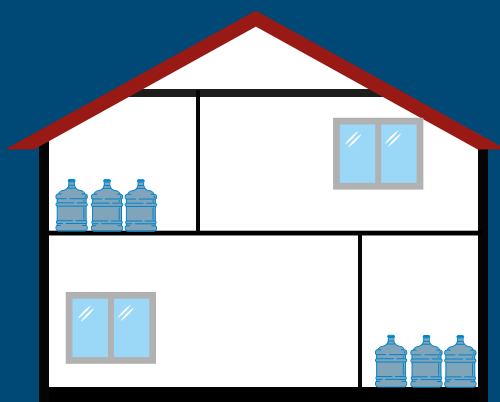
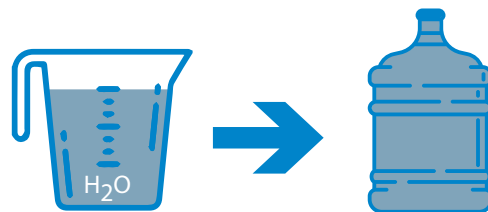
- 4 Wait** at least 30 seconds and then pour the sanitizing solution out of the container.



- 5 Air-dry** the empty container **OR Rinse** the empty container with clean, safe water already available before use.



- 6 Pour** clean water into the sanitized container and cover with a tight lid.



**DO NOT STORE WATER CONTAINERS IN DIRECT SUNLIGHT**



**DO NOT STORE WATER CONTAINERS IN AREAS WHERE TOXIC SUBSTANCES, SUCH AS GASOLINE OR PESTICIDES ARE PRESENT**



**KEEP STORED WATER IN A PLACE WITH A FAIRLY CONSTANT COOL TEMPERATURE**
