

Pressure Regulation & Leak Detection Program

Terms and Conditions

Participating sites must meet the following criteria:

- Live in an eligible retail water agency territory.
- Have an existing, installed pressure regulating valve (PRV).
- The existing, installed PRV must be accessible to the Program field technician via the home's front yard or garage.
- The existing, installed PRV and surrounding plumbing must be in a condition that will allow plumbing work to be performed on the existing pipes. This condition will be determined by the Program Field Technician. If existing pipes are unable to be worked on without being replaced, the site will be deemed ineligible for the Program.

Program Participants (Participants) must specifically acknowledge that participation in the Pressure Regulation and Leak Detection Program (Program) will require persons to enter their property to conduct testing and, if necessary, replace their pressure regulating valve.

Participants must expressly grant permission for such testing and replacement.

Water to a Participant's house may be temporarily turned off during Program testing, and Participants must further agree and grant permission for water shutoff to occur at such time. Additionally, Participants must grant permission for MWDOC to access their water consumption history from their retail water agency. Participants must understand that the leak detection test may not detect all leaks.

In consideration for their participation in the Program, and to the maximum extent permitted by law, Participants hereby voluntarily waive, release, discharge, hold harmless, and relinquish any and all actions or causes of actions, claims, demands, costs, expenses, liabilities, losses, damages, or injuries of any kind, in law or equity, to their property or person, that may have or may hereafter accrue and that in any manner arise out of, pertain to, or are incident to their participation in the Program, as well as, any alleged acts, errors, or omissions by MWDOC, the participating local retail water agency, contractors, or related persons, whether or not such acts, errors or omissions be negligent (active or passive), willful or otherwise.
