The Metropolitan Water District of Southern California

In February 2006, the Metropolitan Water District of Southern California (Metropolitan or District) appointed a new General Manager and Chief Executive Officer to oversee the nation's largest water district. With 1,800 employees and a nearly \$2 billion annual budget, Metropolitan needed a leader with broad knowledge of water issues and strong negotiating skills to ensure reliable water delivery for the 19 million Californians who rely on the District. Metropolitan found that, and much more, in Jeffrey Kightlinger.

During Kightlinger's tenure, historic events threatened Metropolitan's viability–droughts taking a toll on the Sacramento-San Joaquin watersheds and Colorado River systems, reduced delivery from the State Water Project, and the Great Recession, to name a few. Despite these complex challenges, the water never stopped flowing. His depth of knowledge and strength of character enabled Metropolitan to prosper, securing formidable partnerships to bring the agency into the 21st century. Now, after serving Metropolitan as General Manager and Chief Executive Officer for over 15 years, Kightlinger is retiring.
