

Introduction

- U.S. Supreme Court invalidated EPA's Clean Power Plan
- First comprehensive articulation of "Major Question Doctrine"
- Did not reject Chevron deference





Introduction

- Could constrain climate change in agency decisions
- Relied upon by future litigants
- 6-3 Decision
 - Chief Justice Roberts Majority Opinion
 - Justice Gorsuch Concurring Opinion
 - Justice Kagan Dissent

- Three Main Regulatory Programs
 - National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS) Program
 - Hazardous Air Pollutants (HAP) Program
 - New Source Performance Standards Program



- October 2015 Two New Rules re: Carbon Dioxide
 - First Rule New power plants
 - Second Rule Existing power plants





- Generation Shifting-Three Ways
 - Reduce plants electricity production
 - Build new facility or invest in another facility
 - Cap and trade regime





- Clean Power Plan never goes into effect
 - U.S. Supreme Court stays plan
 - DC Circuit hears oral argument
 - EPA repeals rule
 - DC Circuit rules
 - US Supreme Court granted certiorari



Decision - Majority

- Standing
- Major Question Doctrine





Decision - Majority


- Major Question Doctrine—Doctrine Implicated When:
 - Agency's claim of authority pertains to an issue of vast economic and political significance
 - Where Congress has not clearly empowered the agency to take such extraordinary action





Decision - Concurring

Outlined series of factors establishing statement of sufficient authority





Decision - Dissent


- Key reason for broad delegations is so agency can respond to new and big problems.
- Claim majority has adopted new canon of construction not within text of statute





Impact - Nationally

- Clean Air Act and climate change
- On other federal administrative actions





Impact - Nationally

Examples:

- Securities and Exchange Commission
- Federal Trade Commission
- Federal Workplace Law
- Clean Water Act
- Endangered Species Act
- Toxic Substances Act
- Safe Drinking Water Act
- Pandemic Protections
- Food and Drug Administration









Impact - Locally

- State Administrative Actions
- Senate Bill 1
- Clean Water Act in California
- Federal water issues impacting California
 - Colorado River
 - Bureau of Reclamation
- US FWS and NMFS rulemaking
