Project Scope & Funding

1. How much grant funding is available?

The District does not apply for or distribute grant funding for this program. MWDOC does not guarantee a specific annual funding level for this program, as funding is dependent on participation by water providers and the budget amounts established by each participating agency. For Fiscal Year 2025–2026, the total program budget is \$487,658. Actual funding levels in future years may vary.

2. What is the scope of the pre & post activities? Are there any limitations or requirements to keep in mind?

The selected vendor has flexibility in designing the pre-program and post-program activities with input and guidance from MWDOC. Activities should be designed as part of a cohesive structure that connects the program's learning objectives and outcomes from start to finish. Activities should be:
